Architects of Justice: Arbitration & Dispute System Design

Dirk Pulkowski is a Senior Legal Counsel at the Permanent Court of Arbitration (PCA) in The Hague, the Netherlands. Dr. Pulkowski has broad experience heading PCA teams as registrar or institutional secretary in arbitrations between States, investor-State arbitrations and contract-based arbitrations.

He has also represented the PCA in diplomatic settings, including the United Nations General Assembly, UNCITRAL, the OECD, the conference of the States parties to the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea and the Energy Charter.

Dr. Pulkowski teaches international investment law in the LL.M. programme of the Université libre de Bruxelles (ULB). Prior to joining the PCA in 2009, Dr. Pulkowski practiced as a lawyer in the international trade and arbitration group of an international law firm. Dr. Pulkowski holds a doctorate in law, summa cum laude, from Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität, Munich, Germany, and an LL.M. degree from Yale Law School, New Haven, United States.
