



Sanctions and Institutional Arbitration - Launch of the DIS Sanctions FAQ

Sanctions regimes are increasingly influencing the conduct of international arbitration – posing challenges for institutions, arbitrators, and parties alike. How do arbitral institutions handle proceedings involving sanctioned parties? What legal and operational hurdles arise in administering such cases? And what role can institutional guidance, such as FAQs, play in reducing uncertainty?

The discussion marks the launch of the new DIS FAQ on sanctions, designed to assist parties, counsel, and arbitrators navigating this evolving area.
